CITY OF LOGAN TO HOST 2024 QUEENSLAND JUNIOR & YOUTH CUPS



In an exciting first for an event that captures the attention of junior and youth bowlers and fans across the nation, **Logan City Tenpin** will host this year's dual **TBAQ QUEENSLAND JUNIOR & YOUTH CUP** tenpin bowling tournaments from 29 June to 1 July.

The sport is enormously popular with teenagers and younger players, and for three full days the centre in Logan Central will showcase some of Australia's best emerging talent.

First held in 2015, the Queensland Junior Cup is now established as one of the most popular fixtures in the series of ranked tournaments accredited by the sport's national governing body, Tenpin Bowling Australia.

The QJC was expanded to three days last year with the introduction of the Queensland Youth Cup (QYC) for bowlers 21 years and under. The QJC and QYC are now integral tournaments in TBAQ's Junior & Youth Talent ID Pathway Series.

With the enthusiastic support of Logan City Council, this year's carnival of bowling talent will take place in the vibrant and culturally diverse City of Logan ([Home - Explore Logan](#)), which is less than 30 minutes' drive from Brisbane airport.

"We're thrilled to be hosting this prestigious event ... centrally located between Brisbane, Ipswich and the Gold Coast, we can guarantee bowlers and their families will find plenty to do while they're here in Logan," commented centre proprietor Bruce Morris. "It's sure to be action-packed both on and off the lanes," he added with a smile.

Regional, interstate and international participants will compete for cash, trophies and prizes valued at over \$12,000. Equal prize money is on offer for both the male and female 2024 QJC and QYC champions and top placegetters, reflecting the gender parity of the sport and showcasing its widespread appeal to the younger generation.
